REQUIREMENTS FOR MOVING A BUILDING

CITY OF ORANGE, TEXAS

1. If a building is to be moved on City of Orange streets and the building is to be placed in the City, the mover needs to:
 - a. Provide the City with a plot plan of the lot;
 - b. Obtain a building permit;
 - c. Obtain a moving permit (\$50.00) showing the dimensions of the building, route and approval of utility companies and City departments;
 - d. Arrange for a police escort

2. If a building is to be moved on city of Orange streets, but the building will be placed outside the City, the mover needs to:
 - a. Obtain a moving permit (\$50.00), showing the dimensions of the building, route and approval of utility companies and City departments;
 - b. Arrange for a police escort

3. If a building is to be moved solely on State Highways, the mover needs to:
 - a. Obtain a moving permit from the State of Texas Department of Highways and Public Transportation
