Application is hereby made for an Itinerant Vendor to engage in the *TEMPORARY* or *TRANSIENT* business in the City of Orange to sell or exhibit any goods or merchandise upon the property of another, as provided for in the City of Orange Revised Code of Ordinances.

APPLICATION SHALL BE FILED WITH THE CITY SECRETARY AT LEAST FIVE (5) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF CONTEMPLATED SALE.

BEFORE PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED, THIS APPLICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FOLLOWING:

1. Written consent from the property owner or authorized agent to grant consent for use of such private property.
2. An original Sales Tax Permit issued by the Comptroller of the State of Texas.
3. A bond in the amount of not less than Five-Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars payable to the City of Orange. Said bond shall remain in full force and effect for the duration of the permit and two years thereafter.
4. A copy of Health Inspection Report if you are selling foods intended for human consumption.
5. A statement showing the kind and character of the goods, wares or merchandise to be sold, offered by sale, or exhibited.
6. A certified copy of the Charter if you are a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Texas.
7. A certified copy of your permit to do business in the state if you are a corporation incorporated under the laws of another state.
8. Approval of the location and type of sales facility must be obtained from the Police Department, Fire Marshall and the Building Official.

A permit shall be issued only after all of the above provisions of this application have been met and a permit fee has been paid. The permit will not be transferable nor give authority to more than one person to conduct a business as an Itinerant Vendor. Any person having obtained such permit may have one or more assistants to conduct business.

NOTE: Each person who solicits door to door must possess a solicitor's permit.

THE PERMIT IN NO EVENT SHALL CONTINUE FOR MORE THAN ONE YEAR.

The permit must be displayed in a conspicuous location. Failure to comply with any regulations shall result in immediate closure of the vendor's temporary location and shall be considered a Class C misdemeanor. Any person violating any of the provisions of this application shall be fined an amount of not more than Five-Hundred (\$500) Dollars for each offense.
